- If you have received services or support from ESF, or if you have volunteered at any ESF events, please describe your experience and how it has been impactful to you.
- Describe your post-secondary goals and aspirations and indicate whether it is your first time or if you are a returning college student. Include why you chose your intended major and how you will apply your education to make a difference after college.
- Describe how epilepsy has impacted your education and/or job experience.
- Describe any relevant accomplishments, academic awards, sports participation, extracurricular activities, volunteer involvement, etc.

Separate from the personal essay, please provide a detailed explanation of your financial status, including any factors affecting your ability to pay for your education, such as family or personal income, expenses, outstanding debts, or any other information that may further explain your financial status.
